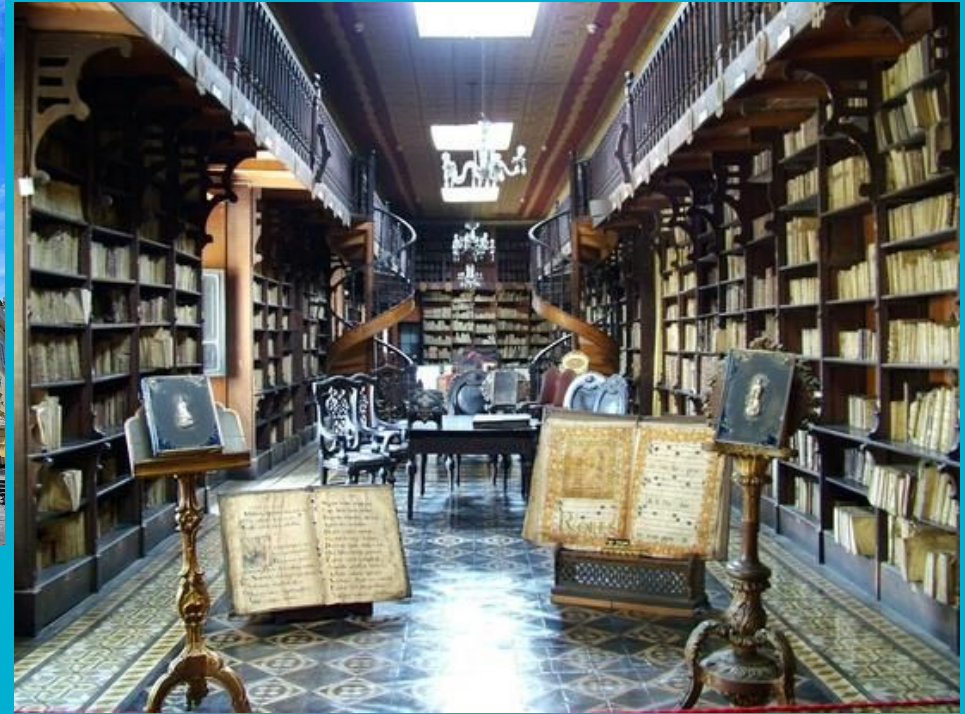

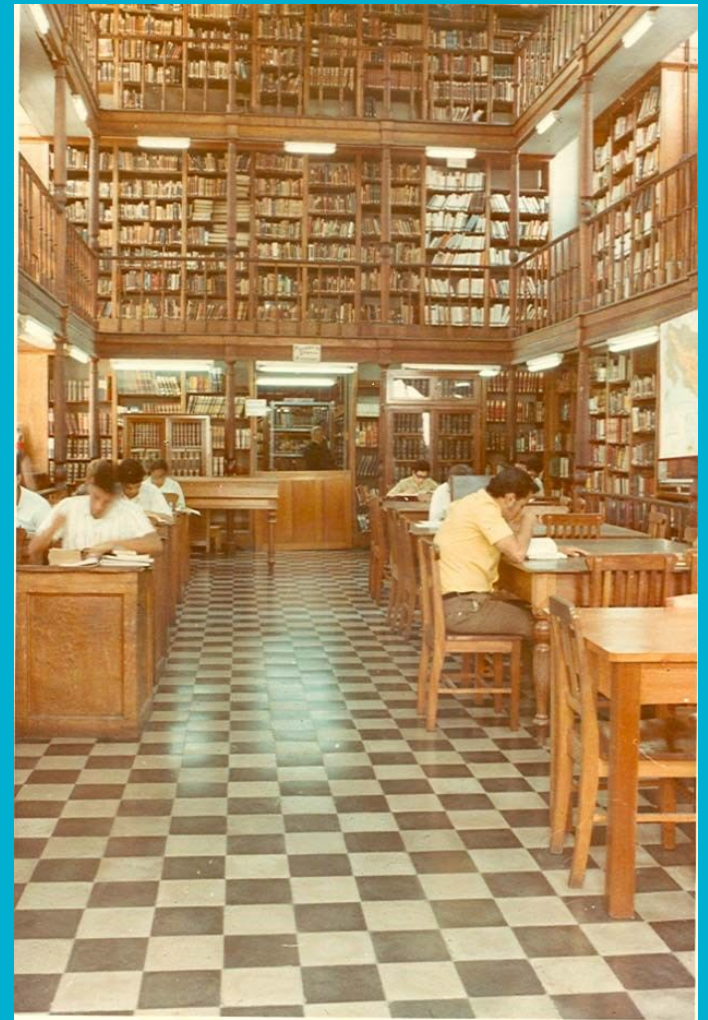

The Lost City of Gold in Guatavita EL DORADO (Colombia)

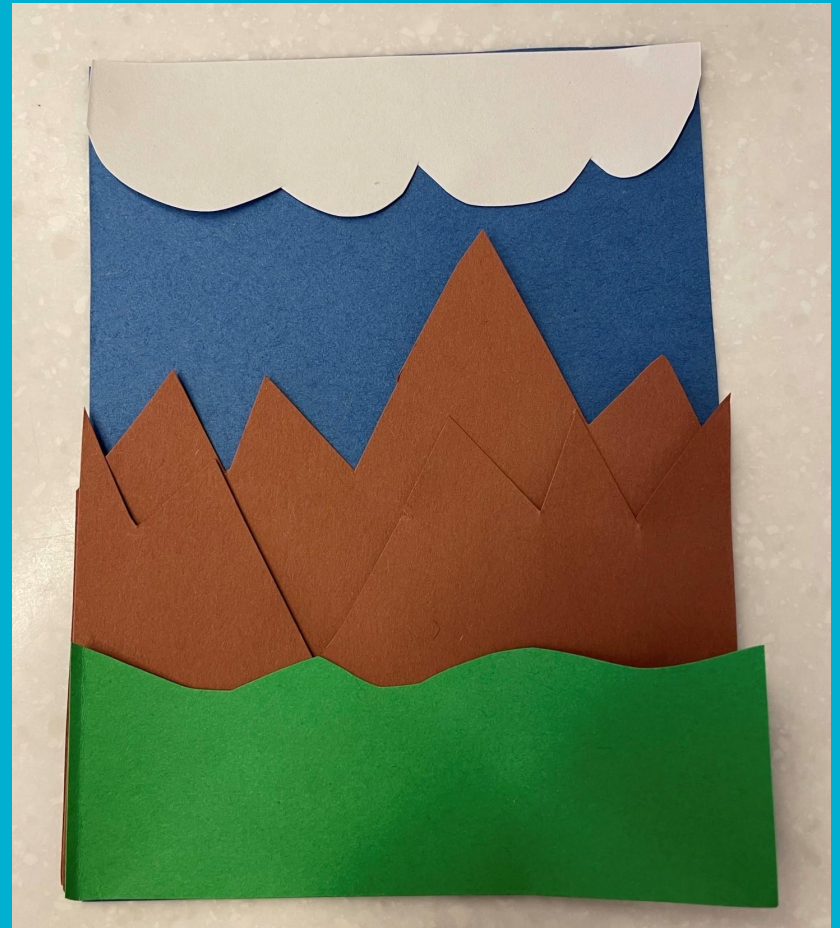
Instructions: Unwrap your clay but save the plastic wrap. Roll your clay into a ball, press your finger into the middle to make a small dip, press your ring into the middle. Leave over night to dry and paint the middle with blue marker and wrap the plastic over and it will look like the ring is reflecting.

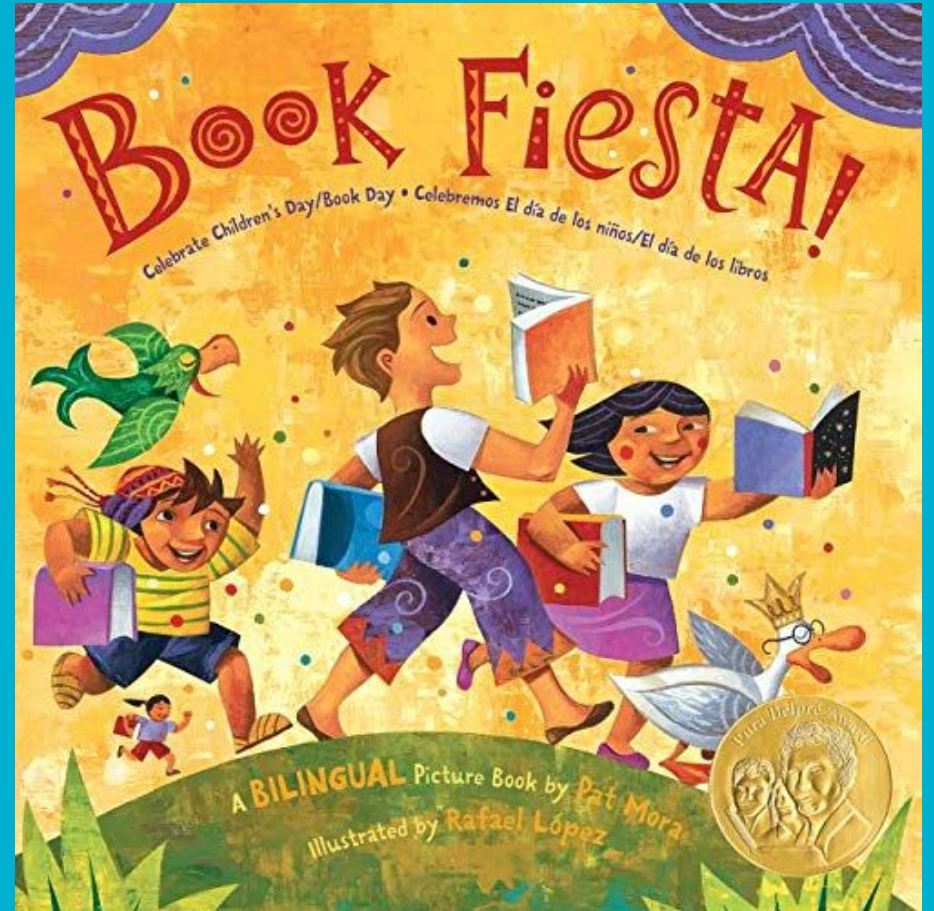

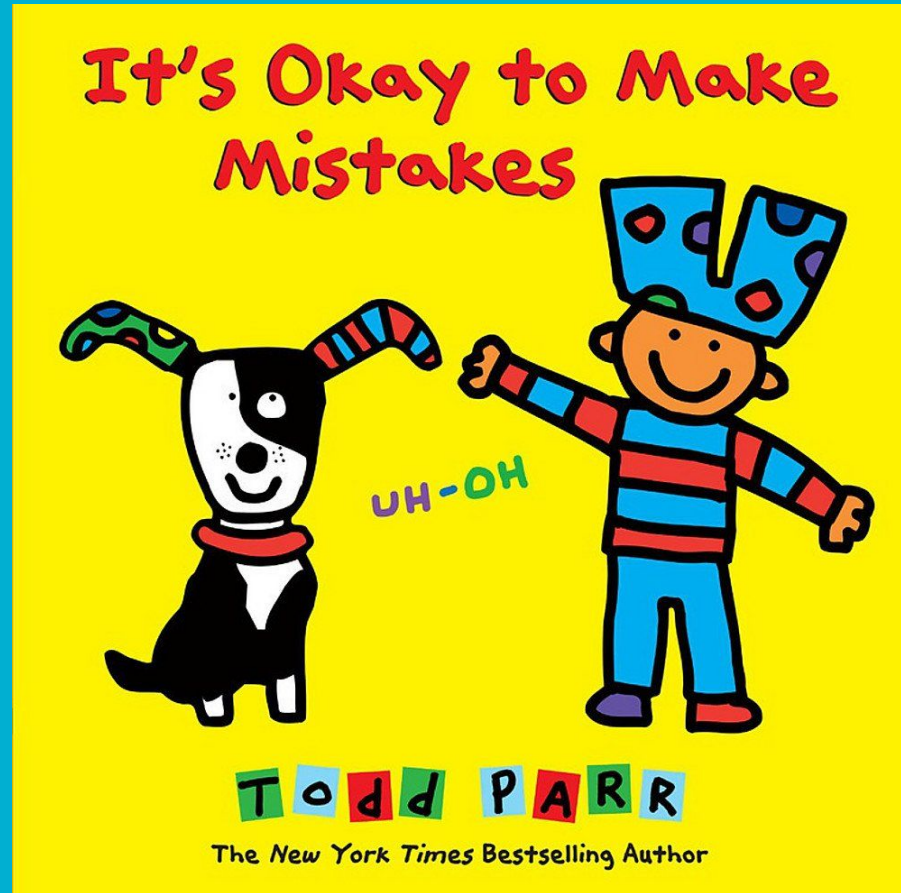
